Plant Name	Size	Description
Dichroa febrifuga Evergreen Hydrangea	5 X 5	Light blue flowers with dark green leaves resemble a hydrangea but is not in the Hydrangea genus. It is evergreen to about 20 degrees but will defoliate below this temperature.
Hydrangea anomala petiolaris Climbing Hydrangea	20 X	A vigorous, deciduous vine that climbs by aerial roots. White fragrant flowers form showy clusters during the summer. Pealing reddish brown bark add winter interest.
Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle' Smooth Hydrangea	6 X 6	Huge snowball like flowers open as a lime green and turn to a pure white. Blooms form on new wood, prune close to the ground in late winter to encourage new growth.
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailipse' Light O' Day	4 X 3	Beautiful lace cap flowers add to the attractive variegated foliage. The white and green variegated leaves of this compact shrub is striking even when not in bloom.
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Bailmer' Endless Summer Hydrangea	5 X 5	This reblooming hydrangea is very cold hardy and disease resistant. Large flowers and deep green foliage make this hydrangea a must for any shade garden.
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Big Daddy'	5 X 5	Giant clusters of flowers bloom from early summer till fall. Dark green glossy leaves on sturdy branches form a rounded shrub.
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Blushing Bride'	5 X 5	White simi-double blooms fade to a pink blush. This hydrangea is disease resistant and very cold hardy
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Fasan' Big Leaf Hydrangea	5 X 5	The bright red lace cap flowers really stand out sitting on top of this large shrub. The dark green foliage is a nice contrast to the bright flowers.
