

REDBUDS

Name	Size	Description
Cercis canadensis	25' X 25'	The Eastern Redbud is found growing native as an under story tree in well drained soils. The tree has large heart shaped leaves that are a dull green in color. The blooms are a pinkish purple color that emerge before the leaves in the Spring.
Cercis canadensis 'Covey'	8' X 8'	Lavender Twist is a weeping Redbud that has rosey-pink flowers. The weeping, somewhat twisted branches create an umbrella form. The leaves are a bluish-green heart shaped. This weeping form tends to be more hardy than previous weeping varieties.
Cercis canadensis 'Forest Pansy'	25' X 25'	The Forest Pansy Redbud has rose-pink blossoms that cover the bare branches before the new growth appears in the spring. The new growth emerges a dark purple color and the large heart shaped leaves mature to a greenish-bronze color.
Cercis canadensis var. 'Alba'	25' X 25'	'Alba' is a white blooming variety of the Eastern Redbud. This deciduous tree has green heart shaped leaves. The branches have an upright spreading habit creating an irregular crown shape.
Cercis canadensis var. mexicana	15' X 15'	The Mexican Redbud is a smaller tree than other varieties. The leaves are a glossy green color with wavy edges. Blooms are a rose-purple color and appear in the spring before the tree leafs out. This great accent tree has a very high heat tolerance and drought tolerance.
Cercis canadensis var. texensis	20' X 20'	The Texas Redbud has thick almost leathery leaves with wavy margins. The green leaves have a waxy feel that helps reduce transpiration. This deciduous tree is one of the first to bloom in the spring. The magenta colored blooms on naked limbs announce warmer weather is on the way.
Cercis canadensis var. texensis 'Oklahoma'	25' X 25'	The magenta colored blooms cling to the naked branches in early Spring. The leaves are green and shiny. The seedpods are a purple color and remain on the tree well into the winter.
Cercis chinensis 'Avondale'	20' X 15'	Deep violet-pink blooms emerge in early spring and cover the branches creating a pinkish glow. The heart shaped leaves are a glossy dark green.
